On the night of 1933, the infamous Barrow Gang, comprised of Clyde Barrow, Bonnie Parker, Buck Barrow and his wife, Blanche, and young W.D. Jones, were hiding out near Kansas City, Missouri. The Ford Model A and Tourist Cabins were located just outside of what is today the Kansas City International Airport. Thirteen lawmen had the place surrounded and somehow the Barrow Gang escaped, but not unscathed. While most thought the gang ran straight for Iowa, in fact, they spent most of the night just trying to get out of Platte County.

This event examines the Barrow Gang, the events leading up to the Red Crown affair and its aftermath. Through film, rare slides and various accounts, this historical event will be retold. Following the symposium, the "Escape from Platte County Road Tour" will retrace the actual roads used by the Barrow gang that night, nearly 75 years ago. Today those same roads are newly paved country back roads - perfect for a vintage car tour.

If you're a history buff, a vintage car fan or both, you're sure to enjoy this unique program.

- where gang repaired tire
4. Stop at "The Swary Brick"
- where they rested and treated their wounds
5. Stop at bridge across Little Platte River - Hwy B.
6. Tour concludes at Platte County Courthouse
- where Blanche Barrow was returned for trial
